Public notice is hereby given that a meeting of the Board of Adjustment of the City of Des Peres, Missouri, will be held on the date and time noted herein to consider and act upon the following agenda and on such other matters that may come before the Board of Adjustment.

The Board will consider the following items:

- 1) A request by Steve Askren, property owner at [2405 Hollyhead Drive](#), to construct a garage addition that would encroach 5'11" into the side yard setback establishing a 4'1" side yard setback. Section 404.020 B.3 requires a 10' side yard setback in the D-Residential Zoning District.
- 2) A request by Melinda Klinghammer, property owner at [11712 Devonshire Avenue](#), to construct a deck that would encroach 6'-0" into the rear yard setback establishing a 14'0" rear yard setback. Section 404.030 B.2 requires a 30' side yard setback in the D-Residential Zoning District. Section 406.020 B.1 states an open, uncovered deck or porch may project into the required rear yard setback for a distance of up to ten (10) feet.
