23	Mark Ahrens seconded the motion. A voice vote was unanimous and the April 11, 2018 minutes

26	AMENDMENT OF THE AGENDA
27	Item B. Petition for Conditional Accessory Structure was removed from the agenda. The petition
28	was submitted the day before the deadline, and was thus included on the agenda. However,
29 30	upon review, staff found the application documents to be lacking required information. The
31	petitioner had failed to provide any preliminary submittals, which would have otherwise revealed the inadequacies.

36	NEW BUSINESS
37	A. Petition for Conditional Use Permit at 13275 Manchester Road
38	Petitioner: GoHealth Urgent Care Center, represented by Rudy Yadao, Director of
39	Development and Construction, GoHealth Urgent Care
40	After giving a short background of GoHealth Urgent Care, Mr. Yadao presented a brief slide
41	show that included the proposed changes to the floor plan. GoHealth has no intention to
42	modify the exterior of the building or site, other than replacing the purple awning with a blue
43	awning and installing signage. Mr. Yadao explained that this location would be the regional
44	office for GoHealth and would house offices and a conference room as well as medical exam

rooms. Mr. Yadao states this office will be open 365 days a year, from 8am-8pm Monday

	through Friday, and 9am-5pm on Saturday and Sunday. GoHealth is expected to see 3-5
)	patients an hour in 5 "oversized" exam rooms with electrostatic illuminated "smart" glass
}	enabling visual transparency while protecting patient privacy. GoHealth will utilize mobile x
ļ	ray machines so every room can be used as an exam room. He also states there will be no
5	narcotics on site.

Commissioner Stevens asked if there were any additional regulations per the City for x-ray machines to which the Director of Public works claims just the CUP for the medical office.

Chairman Oeltjen expressed concern regarding the parking calculations provided by the petitioner. He states the patio seating at Panera Bread (St. Louis Bread Co.) was excluded from the parking calculations. Many commissioners agreed the parking calculations should be redone, as the permanent regional offices could have an effect on parking spaces.

Commissioner Wright moved to approve the petition subject to staff certifying parking calculations are adequate and subject to Architectural Review if the petitioner desires to pursue change in façade.
