The regular monthly meeting of the Planning & Zoning Commission was held at the Des Peres Government Center, 12325 Manchester Rd on Wednesday, May 9, 2018. Chairman Oeltjen called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

**ROLL CALL**

The Administrative Assistant, Public Works took roll with the following Commissioners present: Chairman John Oeltjen, Vice Chair Anna Ahrens, Commissioners Terrie Gwin, Jim Kennedy, Mark Ahrens, Tony Pawloski, Mitch Stevens, Jane Langa, Will Mura and John Wright. Also present were Mayor Becker, Alderman Kleinschmidt, City Attorney Kevin O’Keefe and Director of Public Works Steve Meyer.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Commissioner Gwin stated page 2, line 13 and page 3, line 1 should read “Gwin” and not “Twin”.

Vice Chair Anna Ahrens moved to approve the April 11, 2018 minutes as submitted. Commissioner Mark Ahrens seconded the motion. A voice vote was unanimous and the April 11, 2018 minutes were approved.

**AMENDMENT OF THE AGENDA**

**Item B. Petition for Conditional Accessory Structure** was removed from the agenda. The petition was submitted the day before the deadline, and was thus included on the agenda. However, upon review, staff found the application documents to be lacking required information. The petitioner had failed to provide any preliminary submittals, which would have otherwise revealed the inadequacies.

**NEW BUSINESS**

**A. Petition for Conditional Use Permit at 13275 Manchester Road**

Petitioner: GoHealth Urgent Care Center, represented by Rudy Yadao, Director of Development and Construction, GoHealth Urgent Care

After giving a short background of GoHealth Urgent Care, Mr. Yadao presented a brief slide show that included the proposed changes to the floor plan. GoHealth has no intention to modify the exterior of the building or site, other than replacing the purple awning with a blue awning and installing signage. Mr. Yadao explained that this location would be the regional office for GoHealth and would house offices and a conference room as well as medical exam rooms. Mr. Yadao states this office will be open 365 days a year, from 8am-8pm Monday

1 through Friday, and 9am-5pm on Saturday and Sunday. GoHealth is expected to see 3-5  
2 patients an hour in 5 “oversized” exam rooms with electrostatic illuminated “smart” glass  
3 enabling visual transparency while protecting patient privacy. GoHealth will utilize mobile x-  
4 ray machines so every room can be used as an exam room. He also states there will be no  
5 narcotics on site.

6 Commissioner Stevens asked if there were any additional regulations per the City for x-ray  
7 machines to which the Director of Public works claims just the CUP for the medical office.

8 Chairman Oeltjen expressed concern regarding the parking calculations provided by the  
9 petitioner. He states the patio seating at Panera Bread (St. Louis Bread Co.) was excluded  
10 from the parking calculations. Many commissioners agreed the parking calculations should  
11 be redone, as the permanent regional offices could have an effect on parking spaces.

13 Commissioner Wright moved to approve the petition subject to staff certifying parking  
14 calculations are adequate and subject to Architectural Review if the petitioner desires to  
15 pursue change in façade.

16 Commissioner Stevens seconded the motion.
