ROLL CALL

Commissioner Chair Beermann opened the meeting. Administrative Assistant Llorián commenced with the roll call. There was a quorum with Lt. Willoughby, Commissioner Lund and Commissioner Sullivan absent.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Commissioner Ashcraft made a motion to table the minutes of the June 4, 2018 meeting until the next meeting. Alderman Fitzpatrick seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.

ALDERMANIC REPORT

Alderman Fitzpatrick asked if the commission had any Aldermanic questions.

BUDGET

Chief Krumm stated that the department is over budget in building maintenance and first aid supplies. He stated the over budget is due to repairs to the garage doors and making sure the building meets CALEA standards. He concluded that he requesting more money be added to the budget before the end of the year.

NEW BUSINESS

Election of Chairperson for Public Safety Commission

Commissioner Ashcraft made a motion to table the election of chairperson for the Public Safety Commission until the next meeting. Commissioner Beermann seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.

Retirement Announcement – Director of Public Safety

Chief Krumm announced that he will be retiring effective October 1, 2018. He conclude that the Mayor and City Administrator will be discussing the process of how to fill his position.

OLD BUSINESS

Resident Camera Program

Chief Krumm stated that details of the program are still being worked out.

Insurance Services Office Audit for 2018

Captain Hall presented the commission with a pre-survey of the upcoming ISO audit. He had emailed the commission a summary of the upcoming audit and asked if the commission had any questions.

Commissioner Ashcraft asked if Capt. Hall thought if the department is doing well for the upcoming audit. Capt. Hall stated that the department is doing fine on the equipment requirements and that both pumpers have the same required equipment. Capt. Hall concluded that he is working on the staffing requirements to improve the department's score.

CALEA Update

Capt. Quinn presented the commission with a timeline history of the CALEA process that Lt. Willoughby has been working on. He stated that at the moment the few items that must be addressed are the construction issues to meet standards. Chief Krumm stated major construction requirement is the separation of holding cells. He stated that currently the department is not set up to separate females

and males prisons. He concluded that he has been waiting on the architect to get back with him on the alteration requirements.

DISCUSSION

Chief Krumm stated that the event with the Clydesdales marching down Manchester Road was postponed due to the extreme heat. He stated the event was reschedule for October 12th, 2018.

Commissioner Ashcraft stated that 8th annual Hardwood Hills popsicle parade was a big hit with a great turnout. He stated that crew brought plastic fire helmets for the children and that it was a great public relations event.

Commissioner Ashcraft stated there was an excellent article in the Webster Kirkwood Times in the crime report section regarding Apple.
